## Outcomes for pupils

In Y1, Y2, Y3, Y4 and Y5: Teachers will continue to make sure we are excellent learners, with at least 85% of us understanding and achieving our year group's learning objectives by the end of the year.

Y6: With the help and support of our teachers, we will work hard towards the goal of at least 80% of us reaching the expected standard in Reading, Writing and Maths by the end of the year.
