Aims of session

15 parents attended and 15 evaluation questionnaires were returned

Do you now feel more confident to support your child with the KS1 methods for addition?

100% of parents said yes.

Do you now feel more confident to support your child with the KS1 methods for subtraction?

93% of parents said yes.

7% (1 parent) said they felt a little more confident.
